## The Education System of the Czech republic

#### The responsibility is distributed between

- central government
- concept, state and development of education system
- 14 regions
- post compulsory general and vocational secondary education (age 15 19)
- local communities
- compulsory education (age 6 15)

## **Upper Secondary Education**

 Different view how students have to be prepared at vocational schools:

More practical with vocational knowledge?

More flexible with general kowledge?

Children (or who?) decide about their future life when there are 15:

They prefer general upper school – gymnazium (> 20 %)

Upper secondary technical schools

Low motivation to study vocational schools (< 30 %)

(now to be prepared some activities between schools and companies at the regions, no as the state programme)
